Sub: Extension in milling period of KMS 2012-13 – Regarding

Please refer to Letter No. 4(5)/P&S/KMS 2012-13/Policy/2013 dated 30.12.2013 received from General Manager, Food Corporation of India, Punjab Chandigarh on the subject cited above.

2. It is intimated that the Govt. of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, New Delhi vide Letter No. No.5 (15)/2012-Py.1 dated 10th December, 2013 regarding extension in milling period of KMS 2012-13, had extended the period of acceptance of for a period of 30 clear days without carrying charges (storage charges and interest etc.) from date of issue of instructions i.e. 10-12-2013, and the necessary instructions/guidelines were endorsed by the office vide letter no Rice2/2A/2013/553 dated 11.12.2013. Now it has been informed by the Food Corporation of India, Punjab Chandigarh vide letter under reference (copy of letter attached) that after considering the holidays falling during December, 2013 w.e.f. 10.12.13 and during January 2014, the clear 30 days from 10.12.13 work out to be upto 17th January, 2014. It is therefore intimated to accept rice deliveries of balance rice of KMS 2012-13 only upto 17th January, 2014.


3. You are, therefore, directed to bring it to the notice of all the rice millers so that delivery of balance rice is completed up to 17th January, 2014.
