Subject : Extension in milling period of KMS 2012-13- regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Government of Punjab's letter No. Rice-2/2A/2013/426, dated 29.08.2013 on the above subject and to convey the approval of the Government of India for extension in period for delivery of Custom Milled Rice (CMR)/Levy Rice into the Central Pool for KMS 2012-13 upto 30.09.2013. The delivery of CMR/Levy Rice will be as per the cost sheet and FAQ specifications prescribed for KMS 2012-13.

2. It may, however, be noted that this is the last and final extension and no further extension of time beyond 30.09.2013 will be considered by this Department and in case any pendency of CMR, that should be proceeded with as per guidelines issued vide No. 1(2)/2013-Py.I, dated 14.08.2013 and of levy rice, should be proceeded with as per No. 1(2)/2013-Py.I, dated 21.08.2013 of this Department.
